“New Fashioned” Tuna Casserole”

A heart healthy version of an old fashioned favorite!

Ingredients:

- 12 ounces bow tie pasta
- 1 Bunch Asparagus chopped in ¾ inch pieces
- 1 Red Pepper cut in thin strips
- 1 Garlic clove minced
- ¼ cup Onion diced
- 1 TBS. Olive oil
- ½ cup canned black olives sliced
- 1 can tuna in water, drained

Dressing:

- 3 TBS. Grated Parmesan
 - 1/3 cup olive oil
 - 1/3 cup red wine vinegar
 - Salt and Pepper
1. Cook pasta according to package directions, drain and set aside.
 2. Meanwhile, in large skillet, saute asparagus, red pepper, garlic, onion, and olives in olive oil till tender.
 3. Whisk together parmesan cheese, olive oil, vinegar and salt and pepper to taste to make dressing.
 4. Place tuna, cooked pasta, and dressing in large bowl and toss
 5. Serve room temperature or chilled.
